THE K'OZZIE FEST GRAPHIC COMPETITION

The aim of the competition is to build a library of iconic images documenting Sir Strzelecki's explorations in the Snowy Mountains and the Gippsland District, highlighting the input of the Aboriginal guides in the discoveries.

The competition is open to professionals and amateurs, children and adults. Over \$4,000 AUD dollars is allocated for the winners. First prize is \$1,000, awarded by the Polish Consul General. The New South Wales National Parks and Wildlife Service is funding a special, indigenous award. There will also be a number of additional prizes

depending on the number and nature of entries. *Puls Polonii* will offer \$500 to the best item linked to the theme 'A Flower for Adyna'.

The Foundation invites all Indigenous Australian artists and graphic designers to take part in the Strzelecki graphic competition

Competition items may be in the form of cartoons, caricatures, drawings, paintings, computer graphics or collages incorporating the existing iconography.

The awarded works will be exhibited during K'Ozzie Fest 2009 in Jindabyne and Cooma and will be published in a special festival Anthology. Winners will be officially announced on April 19, 2009, during the festivities in Cooma.
